HOLIDAY CLASS PARTIES - There are three class parties throughout the year: Halloween, December holiday, and Valentine's Day. Parties are parent planned and led. Volunteers are needed to chair, plan, attend and/or donate items.

CARNIVAL- One of Crestwood's great traditions is to have a school carnival. It is a funfilled family experience. Many volunteers are needed to help make it a success.

CLASSROOM VOLUNTEER - An opportunity to volunteer in your child's class.

CRESTWOOD CARES - Short-term help to Crestwood families in need.

DARE - Our fifth graders participate in the D.A.R.E. program. Parents are invited to their graduation in the spring. Refreshment donations are needed.

This involves general landscape bed maintenance, pulling weeds, pruning, spreading mulch, etc.

GIVING TREE - An opportunity for Crestwood families, teachers and staff to help disadvantaged children during the holidays by donating gifts.

HEAD ROOM PARENT - Responsible for coordinating all three classroom parties. The Head Room Parent will organize classroom volunteers based on the teacher's needs.

MILEAGE CLUB - Mileage Club is Crestwood's fitness program available to all students in grades DK-5 as well as any Crestwood staff member. Our Mileage Club will be open 3 times per week September through November and April-May during lunch.

OFFICE HELP - Help is needed with laminating.

PASTRIES WITH PARENTS - An opportunity for parents, grandparents, guardians, or your child's special someone to come hang out before school and enjoy yummy treats. Held twice a year.

PICTURE DAY - Parent volunteers are needed to help assist with picture day in the fall, spring and retakes.

RELAY FOR LIFE - The American Cancer Society hosts regional and local Relay for Life events throughout the country to raise money for cancer research. Rockford's is held at North Rockford Middle School over a 24 hour period. Volunteers are needed to walk and man the Crestwood booth.
